**Union Hotel, Odstrcilovo nam, 1128 00 Prague 2**

The hotel Union was built in 1906 and renovated in 1992. The hotel is situated in Prague's historical centre, 5 minutes from the Congress Palace and the Vysehrad Castle.

The hotel has 57 modern rooms, equipped with toilet, bath or shower, hair dryer, telephone, satellite TV, radio and minibar. Money exchange, souvenirs and a safe for valuables are available at reception. Free parking is provided.

The restaurant offers Czech and international cuisine. There is a bar with a view of the Castle and a wide selection of drinks.

English and German is spoken at reception, and we accept payment by all major credit cards.

Price of a double room: €87

**Axa Hotel, Na Porici 40, 110 00 Prague 1**

The hotel Axa was constructed in 1932. The hotel is ideally situated in the heart of enchanting Prague, just 150 metres from the nearest metro station.

The hotel offers 132 rooms equipped with private bathrooms, colour satellite TV and direct-dial telephones. We have a full restaurant service providing Czech specialities, as well as international cuisine. We also have excellent recreational and fitness training facilities, including a 25m long indoor heated swimming pool (1.50 per hour). You can enjoy a sauna (3), massage or a visit to the solarium.

Parking is available at a price of 260 CZK (Czech crowns). Price of a double room: €124

**Hotel Mepro, Viktora Huga 23, 150 00 Prague 5**

The hotel Mepro is very conveniently located near Arbes Square in the historical centre of Prague, below Prague castle and on the left bank of the Vltava River.
